LOWER SCHOOL STUDY HALL

<u>PURPOSE</u>: Study Hall is a supervised study time for Groups I-IV students who are waiting to leave on a bus or waiting to be picked up by a MS or US sister. Also eligible are those students whose pick-up time conflicts with the pick-up time for a sibling at an area school (with approval from the Head of Lower School). Only these students may attend.

We do not have Study Hall on Fridays as MS dismissal is much later than the LS dismissal time, and to date none of the bus companies have been willing to pick up at noon on Fridays.

<u>TIME</u>: Study Hall starts the first day of school, beginning at dismissal and lasting until 3:45 PM, at which time bus riders are brought to the Upper School Circle to meet the bus. *All other students must be picked up from Study Hall by 3:45 PM.*

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS: Although the time is brief, we hope that your daughters will use Study Hall to start their homework, so they have less to do when they get home. Here are the guidelines for your daughter to follow:

- Bring all the materials and books you need for that day's homework.
- Find a seat on the gathering stairs or in the LS hallway and begin.
- When it's time to leave, please straighten up the area you were using and check out with Mr. Ross-Wiley or Mrs. Schneider
